DEMOGRAPHICS

Midtown West is one of New York City's most dynamic and high-profile districts, known for its world-class entertainment, major corporate headquarters, and unmatched transportation access. Anchored by landmarks such as Times Square, Hudson Yards, and the Theater District, the neighborhood blends global tourism, business activity, and luxury development. With an exceptional mix of office towers, retail corridors, hotels, and dining destinations, Midtown West attracts a constant flow of workers, residents, and visitors. Combining energy, connectivity, and prestige, it remains one of Manhattan's most powerful and recognizable business destinations.

Midtown West has a relatively small residential base, with approximately 50,000–70,000 full-time residents in the broader area, but its true strength lies in its daytime population. On a typical weekday, the neighborhood swells to an estimated 600,000–700,000+ people, driven by office workers, commuters, tourists, and visitors. The area is supported by one of the highest employment concentrations in New York City, with hundreds of thousands of jobs across office, media, hospitality, and retail sectors. Tourism alone contributes tens of millions of annual visitors, heavily concentrated around Times Square, the Theater District, and Hudson Yards. This creates a dense, high-income, and highly active consumer base throughout the day and evening.
